WHAT TO EXPECT FOR YOUR VISIT

The profession of optometry has evolved over the past several years. Focusing on the medical aspect of the eye exam has become standard of care. The medical community relies upon optometrists to detect and monitor such things as diabetes, hypertension, high cholesterol, and autoimmune diseases. We also routinely treat glaucoma, dry eye, eye infections, and monitor for macular degeneration and cataract progression. Our clinic has state of the art equipment available such as OCT, Matrix visual field, retinal imaging, and corneal topographer, enabling us to give you the best eye care possible.

If you are a new patient to us, you can expect your exam to last 45-60 minutes. Your eyes may need to be dilated, and depending on what the doctor finds during your exam additional testing could be necessary. A follow up appointment may be needed to further evaluate any medical condition(s).

If you wear contacts, please know that in addition to your exam you will have a contact lens fitting. This is a separate charge from the exam and may or may not be covered by your insurance company. The fees range from \$70.00 to \$150.00 depending on the level of complexity.

INSURANCE AND FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

Eyes of Oregon accepts most insurance plans. All deductibles, copays, and coinsurance will be due at the time of service. As a courtesy, our staff works with your insurance company to provide an estimate of cost for all exams, materials, and diagnostic testing. Keep in mind this is only an estimate and may result in a credit to your account or an additional balance due once the insurance claim has been submitted and processed. You are responsible for any balance not covered by the insurance company.
